

DRIVING REGULATIONS

Students having a driver's license may drive to school with the understanding that this is a privilege to be handled responsibly. Failure to abide by the regulations may result in the revoking of your driving privileges.

1. Student must complete and return a Student Driver Permit form.
2. Supply a copy of a valid license, proof of insurance and registration.
3. Pay the applicable fee: \$10.00 for sophomores and juniors, \$5.00 for seniors.
4. Students are to park in the student parking lot at all times. There are no exceptions to this rule.
5. Students must enter and exit the student parking lot using the south exit by the tennis courts.
6. Students are to lock their cars.
7. Students are not permitted to go to their cars during the school day unless accompanied by an administrator.
8. Students are not allowed to transport other students from school unless written permission has been given from the parents of all students involved.
9. The speed limit must be obeyed at all times. Students will not exceed **10 MPH** when entering or exiting the parking area.
10. If a student is late to school and receives unexcused tardies for the lateness, that student may have his/her driving privileges suspended for a period of time, which will be determined by the administration. Three unexcused tardies will warrant a suspension.
11. **Excessive tardies:** After 10 late to school, excused or unexcused, a student will lose parking privileges for the remainder of the school year. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
12. Minor violations to these guidelines will result in the student being subject to a fine from the administration. Parking fines can range from \$5 to \$10 dollars.

I have read the above driving regulations and agree to abide by them and follow them closely. Disregard for these rules will jeopardize your driving privileges.
